












- Approximately 41,000 international students live in Sydney (out of 400,000 in Australia, 37% in NSW)
- Sydney is multicultural and the main languages spoken are English (76%), Mandarin (1.6%), Italian (1.4%), Arabic (1.3%), Cantonese and Greek (1.2%)
- There are 600 suburbs in Sydney, all with different lifestyles
- There is a great variety of accommodation in Sydney (backpacker, homestay, share, rental, etc.)
- Students are allowed to work (limit of 40 hours per fortnight)
- Unemployment rate is around 6% (one of the lowest unemployment rates in the world)
- Total population of Sydney is over 5.5 million
- Sydney ranks 6th in the world based on student mix, quality of living, employer activity and affordability
- Weekly food expenditure can be as low as \$160/person if students do not eat outside and prepare their own lunchbox
- Official weekly expenditure as per immigration guidelines is \$381/week/person (\$19,830/year)
- Accommodation prices vary and start from \$150/week/person (average price of decent accommodation is \$180/week/person)
- Health insurance is compulsory for every student (OSHC – Overseas Student Health Cover)
- Main Sydney attractions are the Sydney Opera House, Sydney Harbour Bridge and Sydney Tower
- Australia is generally a very safe place to live and study.


# Visa help, OSHC, CoE and assistance

- Every international student must apply for a visa
- For your visa application you will need your electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCoE) which you will have received from Kingsway
- Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) This is a requirement for entry into Australia, so make sure you have your health cover policy arranged before you leave home
- The Department of Immigration and Citizenship website (www.immi.gov.au) provides all information in relation to visa requirements, responsibilities and compliance
- Kingsway staff can provide you with assistance about all entry requirements for your course
- Education agents can also help with your visa application and paperwork (as well as your course application)
- The main student association is the Council of International Students Australia (CISA) - national peak student representative body for international students studying at the postgraduate, undergraduate, private college, TAFE, ELICOS and foundation level
